Dear Residents and Families.

We are watching carefully with the rest of the country the information and developments about the new Corona Virus outbreak (Covid-19). Because we care for a very vulnerable population, we are implementing aggressive precautionary measures as guided by the New Jersey Department of Health, Centers for Medicaid & Medicare Services and Centers for Disease Control and Prevention.

As of Thursday, March 12, 2020, we are:

- Cancelling all non-essential activities, group events, gatherings and meetings
- Restricting/cancelling all volunteers
- Restricting/ceasing all visitors
- Following all CDC guidelines in terms of isolating and testing residents with suspicion of Corona (fever, shortness of breath, cough in absence of documented flu). Right now, we have not had single case that is suspicious.
